English <mark>Your</mark> Way

English as a Second Language (ESL) Program

ESL Skill-focused (Vancouver, Victoria, Toronto)

Classes are separated according to skill types and student's level. Our signature flexible level system allows students to be placed in different levels for different skills.

ESL Skill-combined (Toronto only)

A 3-hour morning class combines all skills at a similar level; electives are offered in the afternoons.

FREE EXTRA CLASSES AND WORKSHOPS

Students who register for ESL 25 hours/week can take free extra classes and workshops after school to further improve their English while enjoying interest-specific activities.

Specialized Programs

Two types of specialized programs are available to meet students' personal objectives and goals: Language Enhancement programs (BE, PMM, ETT, CACCT), and Test Preparation program (IELTS).

- Direct entry possible with an entrance exam.
- All of the Specialized Programs are full-time, except CACCT.

Business English (BE): 4-8 week certificate program

BE is designed to develop students' communication skills in everyday business and provide a foundation for further studies and career advancement in the business world.

Power-speaking and Modern Media (PMM): 4-8 week certificate program

PMM provides a supportive learning space to practice and improve students' public speaking, communication and presentation skills through the lens of modern media.

International English Language Testing System Preparation (IELTS): 4-12 week certificate program
This intensive program is designed to improve students' test score on the IELTS test (an entry requirement for post-secondary institutions).

Communication for Airline Cabin Crew Training (CACCT): 4-8 week certificate program (Toronto only) CACCT is a part-time program that emphasizes the specific use of English language in the airline industry and is designed to prepare students for future employment as a flight attendant.

English Through Translation - Korean (ETT): 4-8 week certificate program (Toronto only)



University Pathway

SSLC offers academic English preparation programs, Pathway partnerships and support services to facilitate students who aim to study at a North American college or university.

Intermediate English for Post-secondary Education (IEPE): 4-, 8- or 12-week certificate program

This intensive program is designed for students who want to acquire fundamental academic skills in preparation for studies at a college or university.

English for Post-secondary Education (EPE): 4-, 8- or 12-week certificate program

EPE is SSLC's signature pathway program. Upon successful completion of the program, students can apply to select partner colleges and universities without having to take an official English-language test, such as IELTS or TOEFL. Besides exemption from official language test requirements at partner colleges and universities, EPE is an excellent program to acquire valuable skills for academic studies.

Pathway Services (available as part of IEPE and EPE programs)

To support our students' academic endeavors, SSLC provides numerous complimentary services such as:

- Free application assistance for SSLC students (the service is available to non-SSLC students for a fee)
- · Access to experienced and helpful teachers, pathway managers and student advisors
- Support for obtaining (conditional) letters of acceptance from partner universities and colleges
- Guided tours and information sessions at various colleges and universities
- College and university staff visits at SSLC
- Additional learning opportunities including extra classes, workshops and seminars related to post-secondary academic skills

- Our student advisors can arrange trial lessons based on the student's level and career goals.


Option 1 SSLC ESL plus SSLC Specialized Programs

Programs for Teens, Groups and Families

Teen ESL Program (Vancouver only)

In this full-time, year-round ESL program for teens (ages 13-17 years old), students study basic as well as content-based English skills. The curriculum and textbooks are designed for teenagers, and lessons are highly relevant for this age group. The intensive program is available to short- and long-term students, including those going on to a Canadian high school.

Canadian High School Bridge Service (Vancouver only)
